**JAMESTOWN SANITARY DISTRICT ANNOUNCES
IMPORTANT UPDATES FOR OUR VALUED CUSTOMERS**

JAMESTOWN – The Jamestown Sanitary District (JSD) Board of Directors and Staff remain committed to our customers as we navigate this uncertain and ever-changing environment. Amid the unforeseen economic circumstances due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the JSD Board of Directors has enacted the following policies effective immediately.

- The JSD is postponing implementation of the fifth and final year of the adopted fiscal five-year funding plan of sewer service increases until January 1, 2021.

- The JSD is also deferring sewer service monthly late fees, non-payment postings, and disconnections until July 2020. Customers are still responsible for paying standard base rates for provided monthly service, but all other penalties will be suspended. The monthly fees are necessary to maintain the District’s infrastructure of the wastewater treatment facility and collection system.

As a public municipality wastewater sector, JSD is classified as an essential service with an applicable workforce. We are dedicated to assisting customers to the best of our ability during this time.
