Final Year of the Adopted Five-Year Rate Structure  
Increase to Sewer Utility Service Rates  
Effective July 1, 2022

On June 9, 2016 the Jamestown Sanitary District (JSD) Board of Directors held a Public Hearing approving a five-year sewer utility service rate funding plan for the operation and maintenance of the existing and future wastewater facilities, the collections infrastructure and to comply with State and Federal wastewater requirements and permitting. The JSD Board of Directors confirmed on April 14, 2022 to finalize the fifth and final year of the five-year adopted rate structure effective July 1, 2022.

JSD enacted two postponements to the five-year plan effective July 1, 2020 and July 1, 2021 in consideration to rate payers amid the unforeseen circumstances relating to the COVID-19 pandemic. During the two years of postponement, JSD deferred late fees, non-payment property postings and disconnection penalties. Effective September 1, 2021 JSD eliminated customer payment convenience and transaction fees as a savings for our valued customers in order to continue to keep monthly sewer service accounts current and to avoid delinquent account penalties.

Monthly sewer utility service rates per single ESFR issued July 1, 2022 will reflect increase. All non-single ESFR properties, the adopted User Demand factor classification shall be used in assigning monthly sewer utility service rates.

All JSD serviced customers are responsible for paying the monthly sewer utility service fees as billed on their property account for provided sewer service. Monthly set fees are required for the operation and maintenance of the wastewater treatment facilities and collection infrastructure in order to serve our customers efficiently under required State and Federal health and safety guidelines.
